Navigating Through Web Styles

Questions to ask yourself as you navigate to the area in Web Styles to make your change(s)

- Level One – What Section? (Sign In, Main, Place Order, Check Out)
- Level Two – What ASP Page?
- Level Three – What Object do I want to change? (Image, Label, Table, Button)
- Level Four – What change am I looking to make? (Font Attribute, Image, Table Alignment, Back Color, etc.)

Tips and Other Helpful Hints

- When positioning Images, always use the left positioning.
 - After making changes, you must publish.
 - If the edit does not appear with a simple refresh, you may need to close the browser and reopen a new browser (cache issues).
 - You can type the hex code directly into Web Styles for color changes.

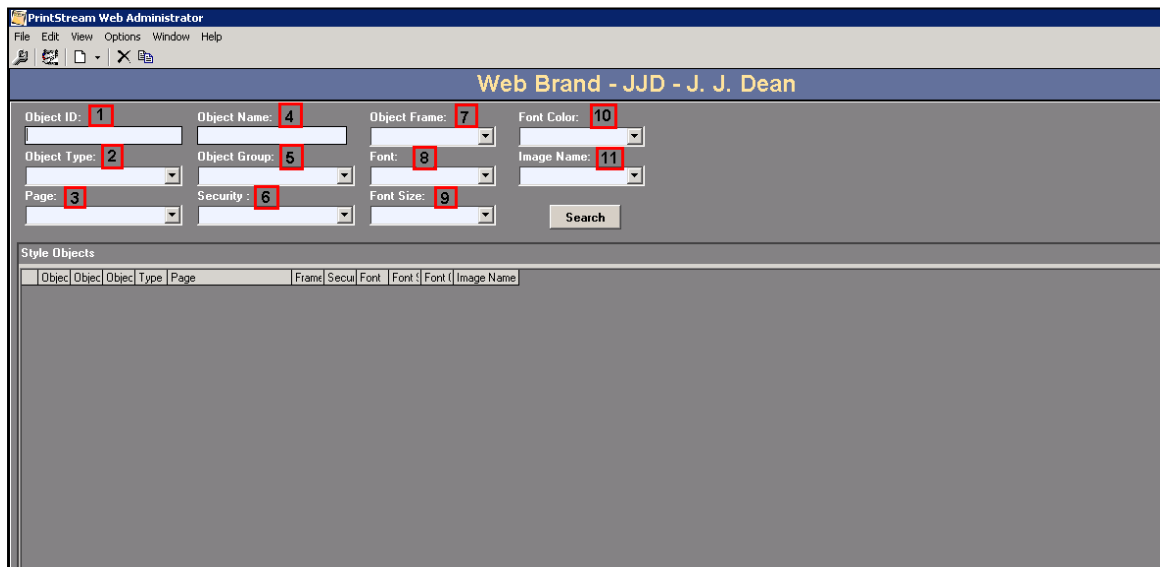
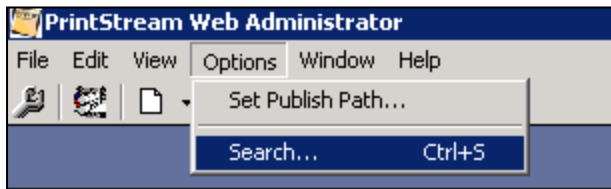

Search Function

The search function allows the user to perform mass changes within the Web Styles tools.

To access the Search feature, the user needs to have a customer profile opened within Web Styles. The Search feature is found under the **Options** tab which is located on the main menu.



- 1 **Object ID** – This can be used by users who can read HTML. While on a web page, the user can select the **View Source** option to determine which objects they would like to change. By entering the **Object ID** and clicking the **Search** button, the Web Style tool will display the object so that the user can make the necessary changes to the object.
- 2 **Object Type** – This can be used by users who can read HTML. While on a web page, the user can select the **View Source** option to determine which objects they would like to change. By selecting an **Object Type** and clicking the **Search** button, the Web Style tool will display the object(s) that are categorized as the selected Object Type so that the user can make the necessary changes to the object(s).
- 3 **Page** – This can be used to view objects from a particular page. This page is often used in conjunction with other selections, such as **Object Group**, in order to narrow a search down to a particular asp page.
- 4 **Object Name** – This is a field in which the user can enter the **Object Name** which is usually the description for the **Object ID**.
- 5 **Object Group** – This box includes the names of all available **Object Groups** within the Web Styles tool. Examples include: **images, labels, tables, table headers, table rows**, etc.
- 6 **Security** – This field allows the user to view all objects that are included in a particular security group.
- 7 **Object Frame** - This can be used by users who can read HTML. While on a web page, the user can select the **View Source** option to determine which objects they would like to change. By selecting an **Object Frame** and clicking the **Search** button, the Web Style tool will display the object(s) that are categorized as the selected Object Frame so that the user can make the necessary changes to the object(s). Examples include: **Banner, Tree, Menu, Main**, etc.

- 8 **Font** – This allows the user to select all objects that contain the selected font in order to make a mass font change. For example: change all **Arial** fonts to **Times New Roman**.
- 9 **Font Size** - This allows the user to select all objects that contain the selected font size in order to make a mass font size change. For example: change all **10 font size** to **12 font size**.
- 10 **Font Color** - This allows the user to select all objects that contain the selected font color (in hex code) in order to make a mass font color change. For example: change all **FFFFFF** (white) font colors to **6C6C6C** (gray).
- 11 **Image Name** - This allows the user to select all objects that contain the selected **Image Name** order to make a mass Image change. For example: If a user wanted to change the shopping cart image throughout the Web.

Sample Search:

If the user wanted to change the attributes of all Table Headers on the **ItemSelection.asp** page, the search screen would look like this:

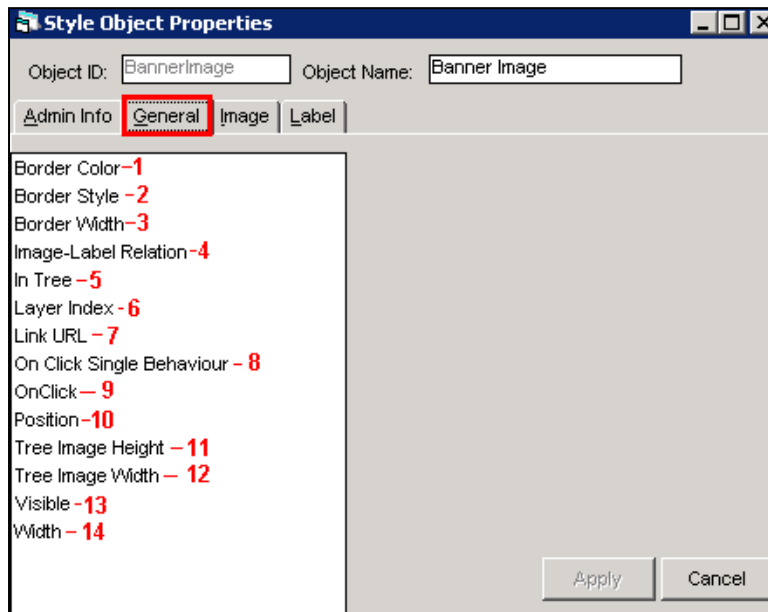

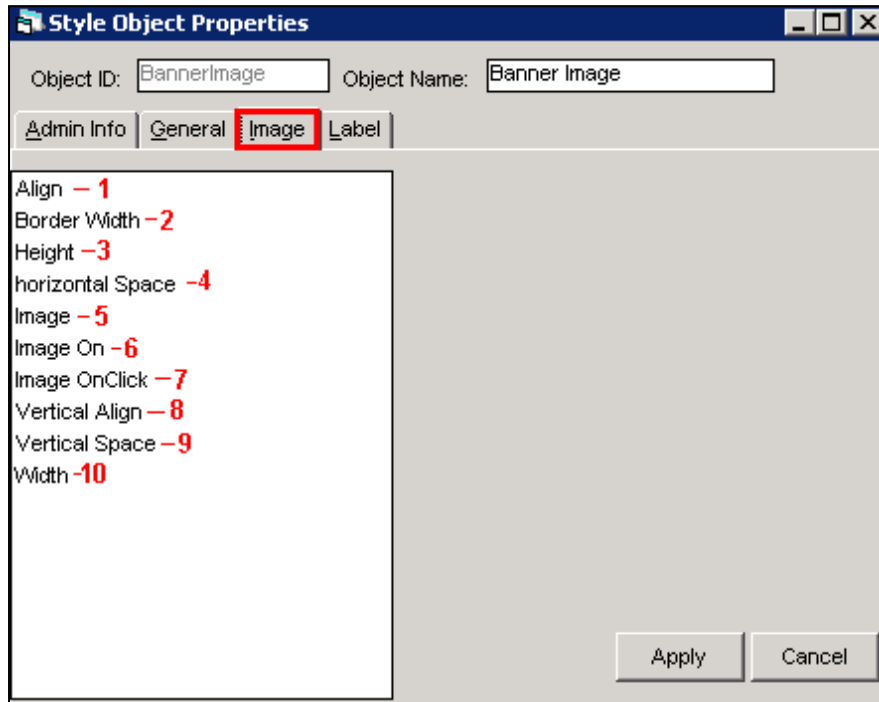
- 1 **Description** – In this area, the user can add a description for the object.
- 2 **Object Frame** – This is a drop-down that identifies which HTML frame the object is associated with.
- 3 **Object Type** – This is a drop-down that identifies which Web Styles Object type the object will be associated with. Example: Images, Textboxes, Labels, etc.
- 4 **Page** – This identifies on which .asp page the object will be displayed.
- 5 **PS Image** – Not currently used.
- 6 **PS Text** – Not currently used.
- 7 **Security** – This displays the level of security needed in order to view the object on the web.

General Tab



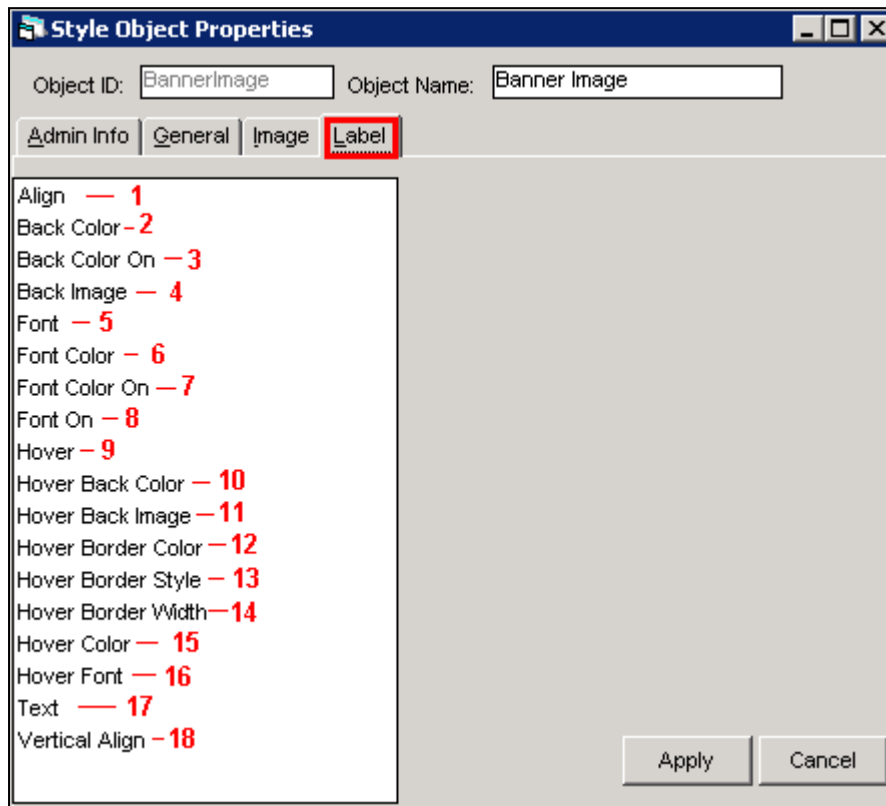
- 1 **Border Color** – This attribute defines the border color to be displayed for the object. This object is used in conjunction with **Border Style** and **Border Width**.
- 2 **Border Style** – This is a drop-down where the user can choose from different border display styles. The most common style is the solid style.
- 3 **Border Width** – This attribute allows the user to define the thickness of the border to be displayed. The higher the number, the thicker the border.
- 4 **Image-Label Relation** – This attribute defines if the object is to be displayed as an image, as text, or a combination of the two. If **Image Only** is selected, the user can skip the **Label** tab. If **Label only** is selected, the user can skip the **Image** tab.
- 5 **In Tree** – This attribute defines whether the attribute is part of a tree structure.
- 6 **Layer Index** – This attribute defines how the web will handle objects that overlap. The object with the higher Layer Index will be displayed on top of the object with the lower Layer Index.
- 7 **Link URL** – This attribute allows the user to define a hyperlink for the object.
- 8 **On Click Behavior** – This allows the user to define if the object is affected by a single mouse click.
- 9 **On Click** – This allows the user to define if the object is affected by a double mouse click.
- 10 **Position** – This allows the user to define the positioning of the object. Positioning can be defined in a couple of ways. These include:
 - Coordinates** – Object position is defined by relative positioning.
 - Table** – Object is part of a larger table and the positioning is predefined in the in the .asp code.
 - Align** – The object is aligned within a table by using the Align attribute on either the **Image** or **Label** tab.
- 11 **Tree Image Height** - Not currently used.
- 12 **Tree Image Width** - Not currently used.
- 13 **Visible** – This attribute allows the user to define whether or not the object is to be displayed on the web.
- 14 **Width** – This allows the user to define the display width of the object. The width is the span of the viewable page and can be entered as either a percent or in pixels.

Image Tab



- 1 **Align** – This is used when the **Positioning** on the **General** tab is set to **Align**. The user can select to align **Left**, **Right**, or **Center**.
- 2 **Border Width** – This is used to display a border around the image. The higher the number, the thicker the border.
- 3 **Height** – This allows the user to change the actual height of the image from the image file.
- 4 **Horizontal Space** – Not currently used.
- 5 **Image** – This attribute is used to attach an image to the object.
- 6 **Image On** – This is a compliment to the image. This attribute defines an image to be displayed when the mouse hovers over the original image.
- 7 **Image On Click** - Not currently used.
- 8 **Vertical Align** – This is used when the **Positioning** on the **General** tab is set to **Align**. The user can select to align **Top**, **Bottom**, or **Center**.
- 9 **Vertical Space** - Not currently used.
- 10 **Width** – This allows the user to change the actual height of the image from the image file.

Label Tab

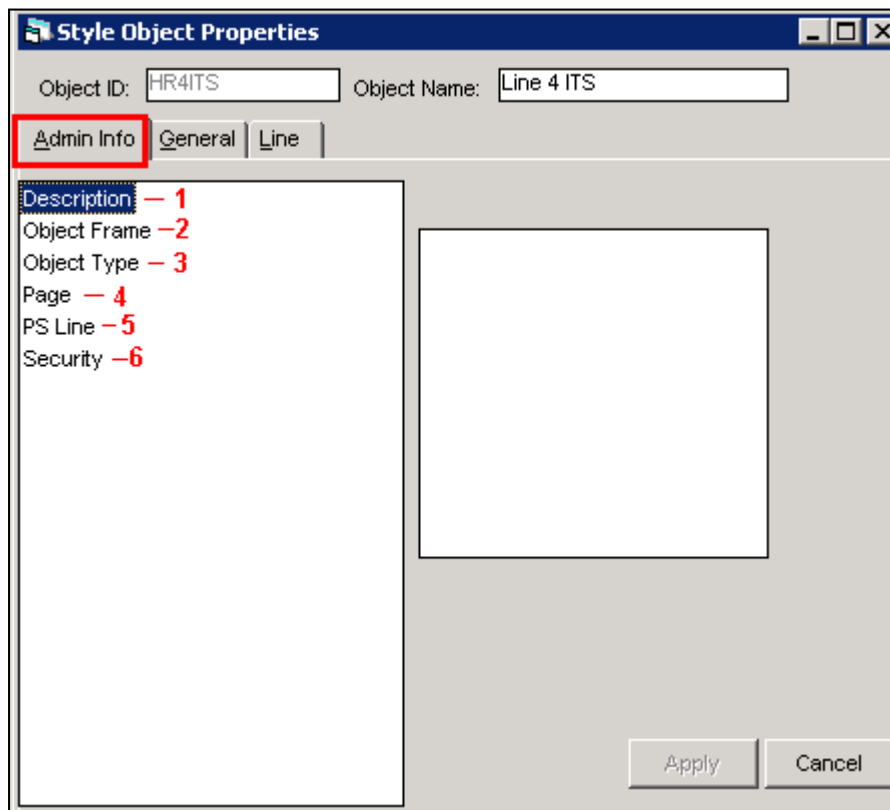


- 1 **Align** – This is used when the **Positioning** on the **General** tab is set to **Align**. The user can select to align **Left**, **Right**, or **Center**.
- 2 **Back Color** – This attribute defines the color that is displayed behind the label text.
- 3 **Back Color On** – This attribute defines the color that is displayed behind the label text when the focus is set on the object. Example is labels in **Trees**.
- 4 **Back Image** – This attribute defines the image that is displayed behind the label text.
- 5 **Font** – This attribute defines the font used to display the text for the label.
- 6 **Font Color** – This attribute defines the display color of the label text font.
- 7 **Font Color On** – This attribute defines the display color of the label text font when the focus is set on the object.
- 8 **Font On** – This attribute defines the font used to display the text for the label when the focus is set on the object.
- 9 **Hover** – This attribute defines whether or not the **Hover** feature is active.
- 10 **Hover Back Color** – When the **Hover** function is active, this attribute allows the user to define the color to be displayed when the user moves the mouse over the label.
- 11 **Hover Back Image** – When the **Hover** function is active, this attribute allows the user to define the image to be displayed when the user moves the mouse over the label.
- 12 **Hover Border Color** – When the **Hover** function is active, this attribute allows the user to define the border color to be displayed when the user moves the mouse over the label.
- 13 **Hover Border Style** – When the **Hover** function is active, this attribute allows the user to define the border style to be displayed when the user moves the mouse over the label.

- 14 **Hover Border Width** – When the **Hover** function is active, this attribute allows the user to define the border width to be displayed when the user moves the mouse over the label. The higher the number, the thicker the border.
- 15 **Hover Color** – When the **Hover** function is active, this attribute allows the user to define the font color to be displayed when the user moves the mouse over the label.
- 16 **Hover Font** – When the **Hover** function is active, this attribute allows the user to define the text font to be displayed when the user moves the mouse over the label.
- 17 **Text** – This attribute allows the user to enter the text to be displayed for the label. This area also interprets and correctly displays HTML tags.
- 18 **Vertical Align** – This is used when the **Positioning** on the **General** tab is set to **Align**. The user can select to align **Top**, **Middle**, or **Bottom**.

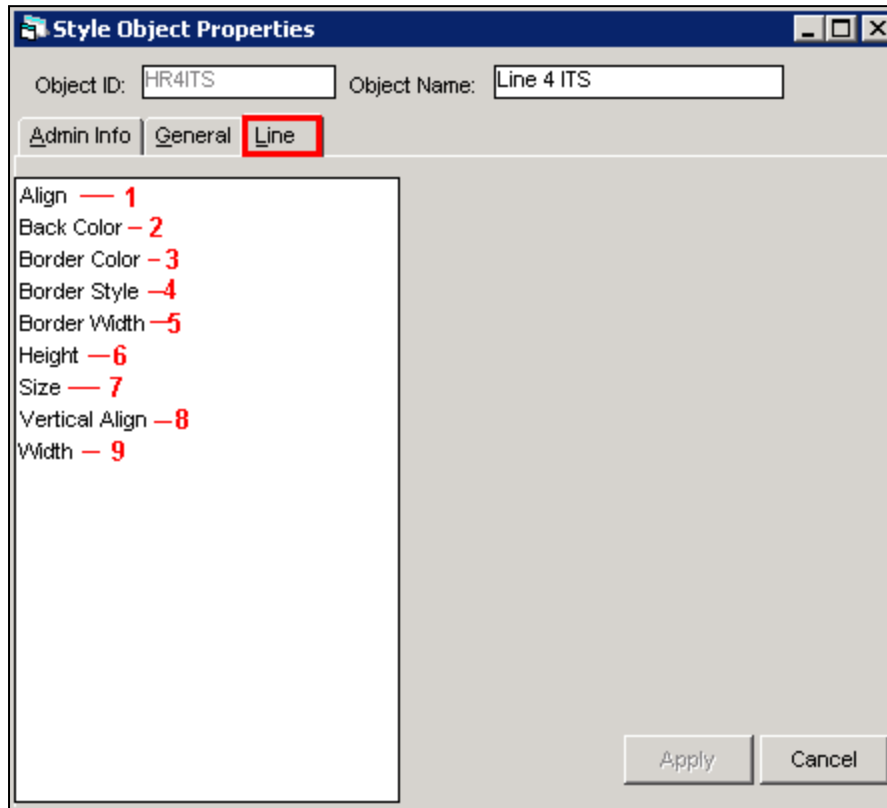

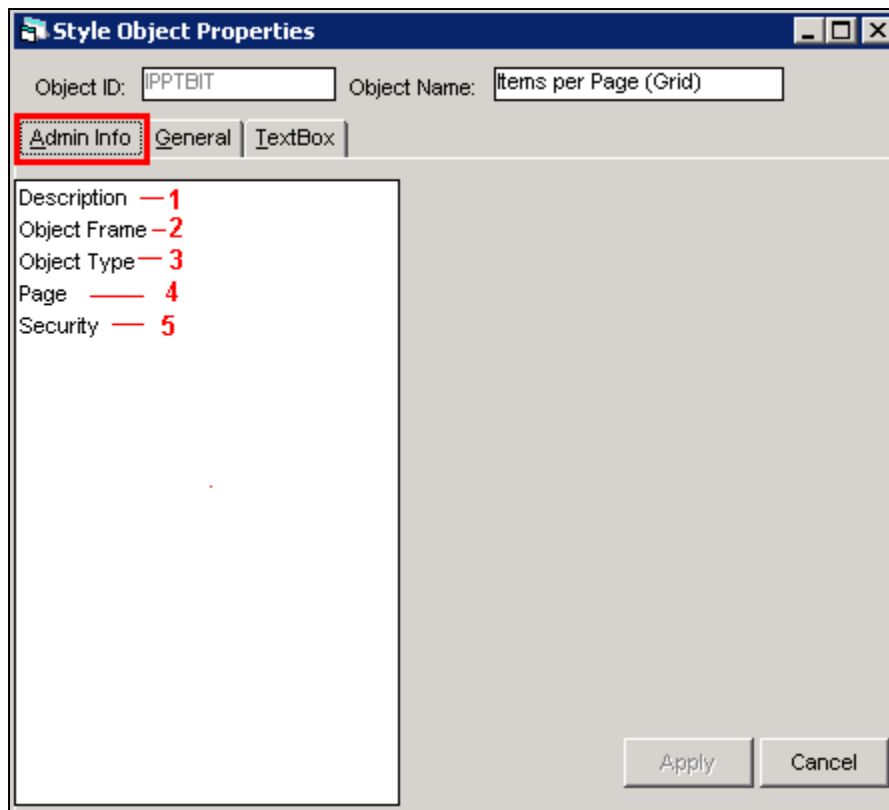
Table Tab



- 1 **Align** – This attribute allows the user to set the justified alignment to the **Left**, **Center**, or **Right**.
- 2 **Back Color** – This attribute allows the user to define the back color for the table.
- 3 **Back Image** – This attribute allows the user to define an image as the background for the table.
- 4 **Back Repeat** – This is used in conjunction with the back image. It allows the image to be repeated on both the x and y axis. (Much like tiling desktop backgrounds.)
- 5 **Border Color** – This attribute defines the color that surrounds the selected line color.
- 6 **Border Color Dark** - Sets the dark component of the 3D look borders. Places in the dark color on the right and bottom sides of the table border.
- 7 **Border Color Light** - Sets the light component of the 3D look borders. Places in the light color on the left and top sides of the table border.
- 8 **Border Style** - This is a drop-down where the user can choose from different border display styles. The most common style is the solid style.
- 9 **Border Width** - This attribute allows the user to define the thickness of the border to be displayed. The higher the number, the thicker the border.
- 10 **Cell Padding** - Not currently used.
- 11 **Cell Spacing** - Not currently used.
- 12 **No Wrap** - Not currently used.
- 13 **Spaced** - Not currently used.
- 14 **Vertical Align** – This attribute allows the user to set the vertical alignment of the table. The vertical alignment can be set to **Top**, **Middle**, or **Bottom**.
- 15 **Width** – This attribute allows the user to set the width for the table. This can be defined as either **pixels** or **percentages**.

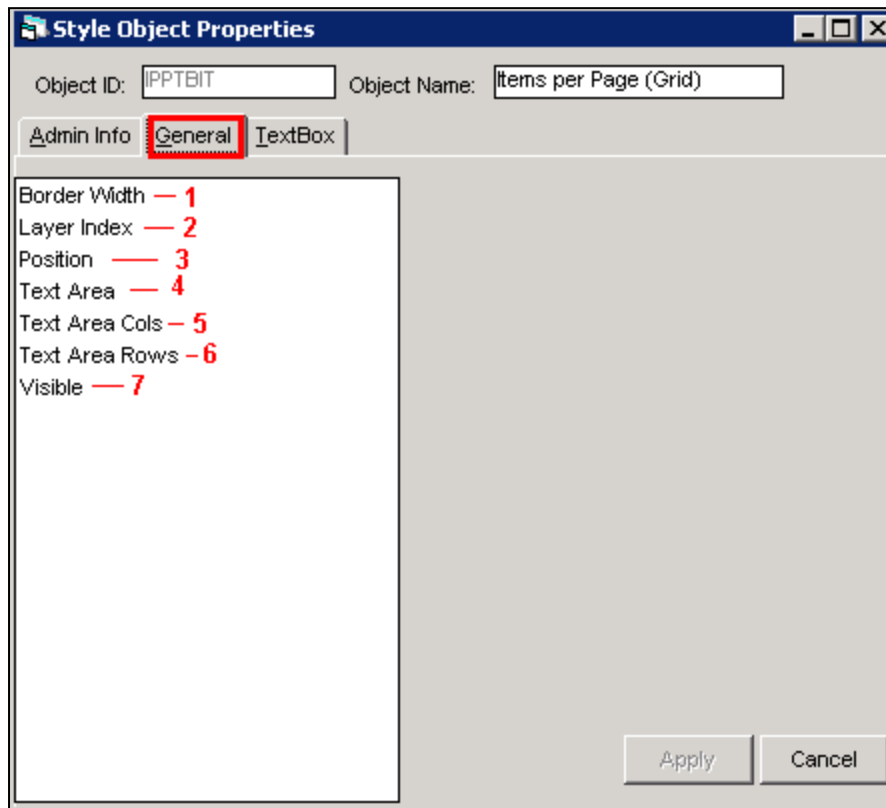

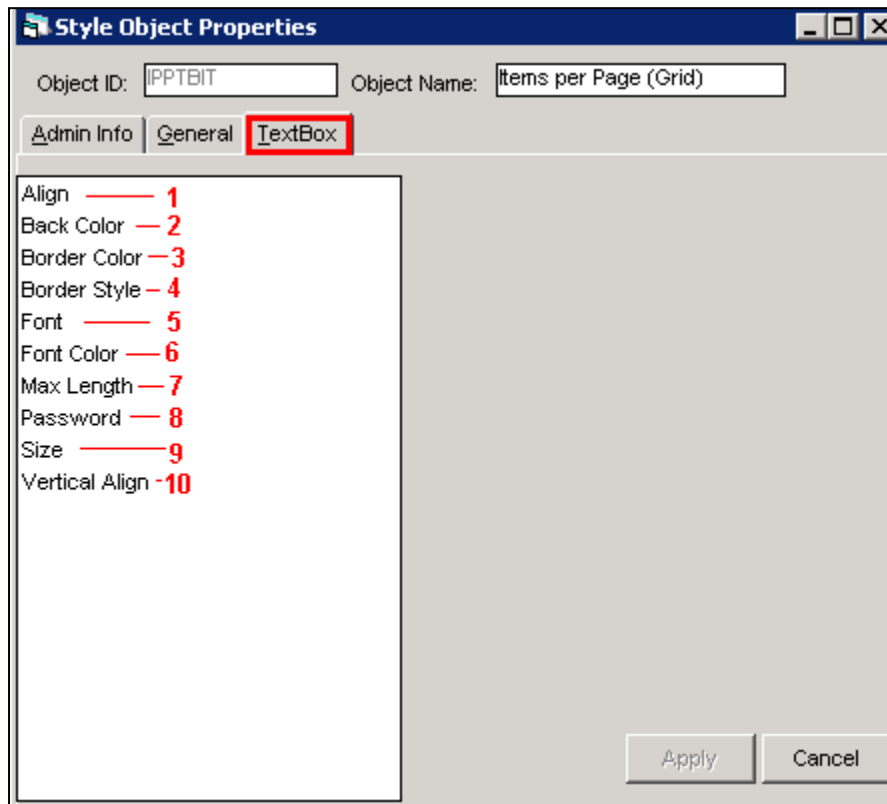

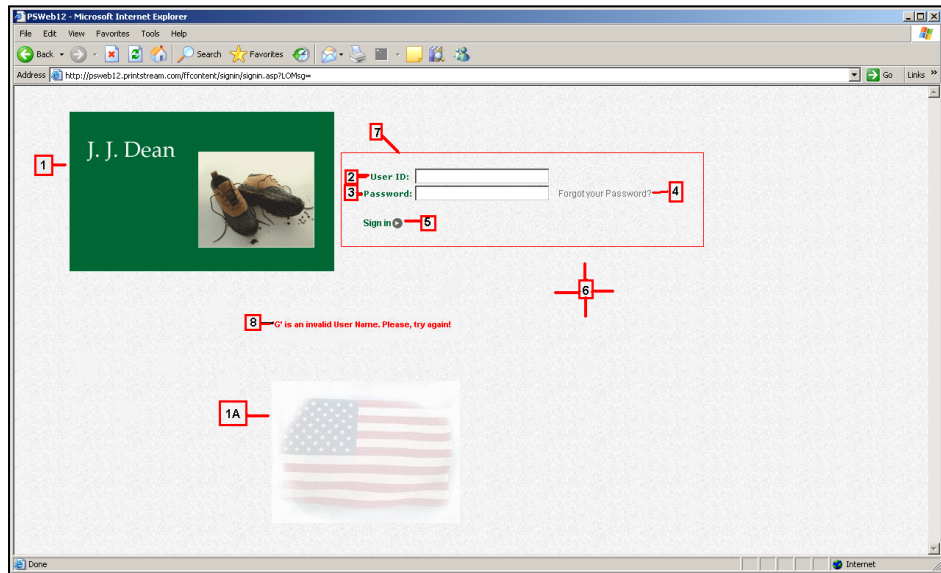

- 8 **Password** – This attribute allows the user to define the textbox as a password. The system will take a password field and display **** instead of the actual text.

- 10 **Vertical Align** - This attribute allows the user to set the vertical alignment of the table. The vertical alignment can be set to **Top**, **Middle**, or **Bottom**.

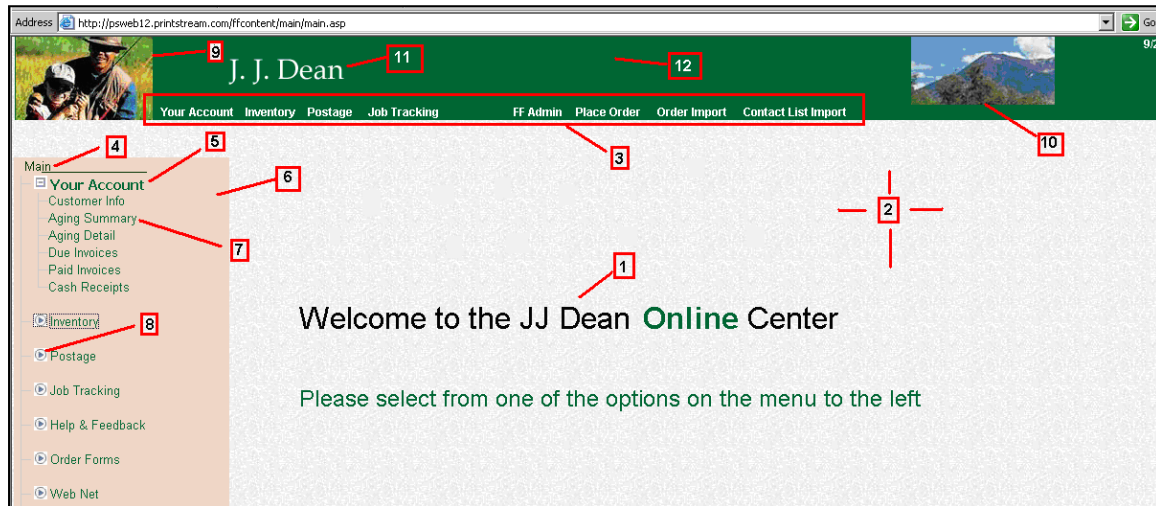
