- Follows job description and responsibilities of the Digital Print Specialist.
- Electronically prepare customer files for various output devices using Adobe Software and Kodak Prinergy Workshop.
- Work with data modules, workflow creation, writing rules, scripts, data transformations within Inspire Designer, XMPie, and Pageflex.
- Process Mail files through BCC Mail Manager Full Service.
- Produce digital and hard copy proofs.
- Provides training for other Digital Print Specialists and Technical Service Representatives.

QUALIFICATIONS

- High school diploma or equivalent.
- Technical college field related diploma or equivalent.
- Computer background, programming training, word processing, graphic and design manipulation.
- Should have experience in all aspects of the software life cycle using Quadient Inspire, XMPie, BCC Mail Manager, Pageflex, Prinergy Workshop, and Adobe Creative Suite (InDesign, Photoshop, Illustrator and Acrobat).
- Experience in the Direct Mail Industry.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS
